How much time will I have to set-up at the centre?

Five minutes set-up time will be provided for you and any other musicians. Please note that the ability to adhere to this time-limit is an assessment criterion.

What do I need to bring to the assessment centre?

- Your assessment slip
- Your CPM Kit with your student number written in the space provided at the front.
- You, and any backing musicians, must also bring your own leads, spare strings, sticks mallets, etc.

Drummers may choose to bring their own cymbals, snare drum and bass drum pedal.

Keyboard players may use the acoustic piano provided, or bring their own keyboard. Keyboard players should also note that if using a taped backing, they should record the backing using a portable tape recorder and **should bring that same tape recorder to the assessment session.** Be sure that all instruments on the taped backing are tuned to A440. These steps will ensure that the backing is in tune with the keyboard at the assessment session.
